MODI-SANCHEZ VISIT TO VADODARA

Security officials work round-the-clock, flyers advised to consider traffic blocks

VADODARA, OCTOBER 25

SECURITY AGENCIES and the district administration in Vadodara are working round the clock ahead of the visit of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Prime Minister of Spain Pedro Sánchez, said officials.

Flyers have been advised to take note of traffic blocks and special arrangements while heading to the airport on Sunday and Monday.

Modi and Sánchez are scheduled to inaugurate the ambitious TATA Advanced Systems Ltd (TASL) manufacturing facility of the C-295 transport aircraft for the Indian Air Force. They will also hold a "vital bilateral meeting" at the iconic Lukshmi Vilas Palace on

Monday.

On Friday, the NSG commandos of the Special Protection Group (SPG) and the bomb and dog squad conducted a thorough check of the route to be undertaken by the two leaders.

Meanwhile, the SPG commandos visited the TASL facility, covering the route from the

airport, where PM Modi will arrive on Sunday morning and hold a 2.8-kilometer-roadshow.

The Vadodara administration on the intervening night of Friday completed the work of installing metal barricades to separate one lane of the road for crowd management for security purposes during the roadshow. The SPG also visited the

Lukshmi Villas Palace where the two leaders will hold a bilateral meeting and sign MoUs on various sectors of cooperation between India and Spain.

While the police is yet to issue a traffic advisory, Commissioner of Police Narasimha Komar told *The Indian Express* that travellers departing from Vadodara Airport on Monday morning are advised to leave early in view of the security arrangements for the event.

"We will issue a notification for diversions and road closures from a security point of view. While the domestic arrivals and departures at the Vadodara airport are not likely to be impacted on Sunday evening as the Prime Minister of Spain is scheduled to land late night, on Monday morning, travellers de-

parting from Vadodara could leave earlier in anticipation of traffic blocks around the airport," Komar said.

Officials of the Vadodara City Police, however, said that Sunday will also witness VVIP movement at Vadodara airport as Union Ministers, including Minister of External Affairs S Jaishankar as well as Defence Minister Rajnath Singh are expected to arrive in Vadodara ahead of Sanchez's arrival to receive the Spanish PM as per protocol. Accompanied by his wife Begona Gomes, Sanchez will stay at a prestigious five-star hotel in West Vadodara on Sunday and head to the TASL facility on Monday morning.

While the city roads are lit in view of Diwali, special cultural events will be held at Lukshmi Vilas Palace for the Spanish PM.

THE AHMEDABAD Detection of Crime Branch (DCB), in a joint operation with the Government of India (GoI), will soon begin proceedings to deport at least 48 Bangladesh nationals who have allegedly been living in an illegal manner in Ahmedabad.

The Crime Branch, on Friday, detained 55 persons. Of these, 48 (31 men, 13 women and four children) will be sent back to Bangladesh soon, said officials. The other seven, all men, remain under investigation, they added.

Hailing the detentions, Harsh Sanghavi, Gujarat Minister of State for Home, posted on X, "Kudos to the Ahmedabad Crime Branch! Based on thorough investigations into ongoing forgery and counterfeit document cases, 51 illegal Bangladeshi citizens have been detained. Legal procedures have begun, and they will be sent back to Bangladesh."

Notably, these detainees will be housed in the new Joint Interrogation Centre (JIC), inaugurated earlier this month, in Ahmedabad.

These foreigners had been allegedly living in India in an illegal manner and were rounded up as part of the Crime Branch's investigation in two major cases: one involving forging Indian identities and the second pertaining to sex trafficking.

According to the Crime Branch, investigators had de-

tected and registered cases of forged documents being used to obtain false identities in which an FIR had been registered against one Faruk Mondal and others under Indian Penal Code's (IPC) Sections 465 (forgery), 467 (forgery of valuable securities), and 468 (forgery with intent to cheat). They are alleged to have forged Indian identity documents and, in this case, the accused and the co-accused have been arrested earlier as well, officials said.

Currently, the Crime Branch is attempting to ascertain the veracity of over 200 allegedly forged documents that had been seized from the accused.

In the case of human trafficking, which also involved minor girls, the Crime Branch had filed an FIR under Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS) sections 64 (rape), 64(2-m) (repeated rape on same woman), 65(1) (rape of woman under 16 years), and 69 (sexual

intercourse obtained through deceitful means), as well as sections of The Immoral Traffic Prevention Act and POCSO Act. "In this regard, the Crime Branch teams raided a location near Chandola Lake where minor girls and women were kept. 100 such victims of sexual exploitation were rescued," said DCP Ajit Rajan, adding that a majority of those rescued were adults.

On Friday, the DCB said that prima facie, these women and girls seem to have been coerced into prostitution, proceeds from which were said to have been sent back to Bangladesh as well. Details of financial transactions and proceeds of crimes remain under investigation.

Apart from the 48 persons about to be deported, at least 150 more suspects are under interrogation and investigation by the Crime Branch, said officials.

Vav seat by-election: Congress picks former MLA Rajput, BJP fields Thakor to challenge him

FORMER MLA Gulabsinh Rajput is the Congress's pick to fight the Vav bypoll scheduled for November 13. All India Congress Committee (AICC) general secretary KC Venugopal said in a statement on Friday. Meanwhile, the BJP has nominated Swarupji Thakor to challenge Rajput.

The Assembly byelection was necessitated after Congress leader Geniben Thakor, who held the seat, won the only Lok Sabha seat for the party from the state earlier this year. The byelection will be crucial for Congress that saw its worst performance in the 2022 Assembly election, winning only 17 of 182 seats it contested along with ally Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) and lost its position as the Leader

of Opposition in the Gujarat Assembly.

Rajput has been an MLA from Tharad, which is also in Banaskantha district like Vav. He will be the candidate for the IN-DIA bloc since the AAP is not fielding a candidate. He had won the Assembly election to Tharad in 2017, serving a single term.

Rajput is a Kshatriya and will be contesting a seat that is said to be dominated by Thakors and

Chaudhary communities, both being Other Backward Classes (OBCs). Meanwhile, the BJP's Swarupji Thakor is a seasoned leader from Banaskantha who fought Geniben Thakor in the 2022 state polls from Vav.

Swarupji Thakor, however, lost to Geniben by a margin of 15,601 votes. Placing its faith in him yet again, the BJP has repeated him as a party candidate.

Party sources said that Swarupji Thakor is considered as a close aide of Alpesh Thakor, a Thakor community leader and BJP MLA from Gandhinagar (South).

Voting for the election is scheduled on November 13.

At present, the BJP has 161 seats in the Assembly, Congress has 12, the AAP four and the Samajwadi Party one seat. Two seats are held by Independents while two seats are vacant.

State achieved significant milestones in transport sector under Modi: CM

GUJARAT HAS achieved significant milestones in urban development and transport under Prime Minister Narendra Modi's leadership over the last 23 years, Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel said on Friday.

The introduction of the Bus Rapid Transit System (BRTS) in Ahmedabad has been transformative, saving commuters' time, reducing stress, and conserving fuel by decreasing reliance on personal vehicles.

The Chief Minister was speaking at the inauguration of the 17th Urban Mobility India Conference and Expo 2024 at Mahatma Mandir. He underlined that BRTS has become a fast and dependable public transport option in other metros across the state while the metro system has become a vital mode

of safe and accessible travel. Modi was the chief minister of Gujarat between 2001 and 2014 before he became the prime minister of the country.

While addressing the event, CM further said that Modi had increased the urban development budget from Rs 750 crore in 2001-02 to over Rs 21,700 crore in 2024-25. The Chief Minister on Friday expressed confidence that the conference would facilitate valuable exchanges on development models and initiatives in the urban mobility sector.

Patel highlighted the Prime Minister's "commitment to environmentally sustainable development with the vision of making India a net-zero carbon country by 2070".

He gave examples of projects like the use of electric and CNG buses in public transportation being expanded under the Mukhyamantri Shaheri Bus Parivahan Yojana and the PM eBus Sewa Scheme based on the public-private partnership (PPP) model.

On Friday, the conference saw the participation of government officials, urban transport and mobility experts, and representatives from various organisations in this field.

Folk singer Gadhvi apologises amid anger over comments on 'robbery incidents' in Dangs

FOLK SINGER Rajbha Gadhvi on Friday offered an apology amid outrage among the tribals over his purported comments in a video widely shared on social media on the alleged incidents of robbery in the forest area of Dangs.

Gadhvi clarified that he had not used words like "Adivasi" (tribal) or "Vanvasi" (forest-dweller) while talking about such incidents.



Will never repeat such statements, said Gadhvi

Tribals were said to have raised objections on the video that purportedly shows Gadhvi at a public event where he is heard saying that "police have been warning people over venturing during the night in the dense forest area like Ahwa in Dangs where people not only rob valuables of the tourists but also take away their clothes".

Social workers, political leaders and locals reacted strongly to the comments, saying that the people of Dangs are tribals and they are innocent. The district receives a large number of visitors not only from Gujarat but across the state.

Snehal Thackrey, a social worker, on Thursday handed a memorandum to Tapi's Superintendent of Police Yashpal Jaganiya and requested him to register an offence against the folk singer for hurting sentiments of "innocent people of Dangs".

"Such statements given by folk singer Rajbha Gadhvi have hurt the sentiments of tribal people of Dangs and strict legal action should be taken against him," the memorandum read. The purported video was also shared by Dangs BJP MLA Vijay Patel, Valsad BJP MP Dhaval Patel, and BJP MP Prabhu Vasava, among others, on social media as they sought apology from the folk singer.

On Friday, apologising over the incident, Gadhvi said, "In the video, I have not uttered words like Vanbandhu (friend of the forest), or Adivasi. I am also Vanbandhu and belong to the Schedule Tribe. I belong to Gir. I just said that robbery incidents take place in the deep forest area in Dangs."

"I have not said that the robbers are tribals. They (robbers) may be from other districts or areas. I have come across information about several people getting hurt. But my intention was not to hurt them and even if I have hurt their sentiments, I put forward my apology. I assure you that in future I will never repeat such statements."

Speaking with *The Indian Express*, Dangs superintendent of police Yashpal Jaganiya said, "We have started a probe on the basis of the application (by Thackrey). Before registering an offence, we will check whether this video is doctored or not. We will send a copy of it to the Forensic Science Laboratory."

TIGHT SECURITY

WITH PRIME Minister Narendra Modi and his Spanish counterpart Pedro Sanchez scheduled to hold a "vital bilateral meeting" at the iconic Durbar Hall of the Lukshmi Villas Palace in Vadodara on Monday, followed by a royal lunch, the Gaekwad Baroda Golf Club (GBC) — Gujarat's oldest private golf club located in the heart of the city — has issued guidelines to members along with a closure notice for Monday due to security concerns. The golf course is wrapped around the estate of the majestic palace and accordingly, with the Special Protection Group (SPG) landing in Vadodara to ensure the security protocol, the club has advised members to be ready for security checks. With police and other security personnel already placed at vantage points in the palace estate, members, especially golfers have been asked to ensure that the caddies wear special jackets for identification to be provided by the club. On Monday, the club, as per the advice of the security personnel, will remain closed, even for its members, until 4 pm.
